2010 County Impacts and Outcomes

Educational Program Focus:

- **4-H/Youth Development**
 - 725 youth ages 8-18 participated in 4-H activities in order to become competent, caring, confident and contributing citizens
 - 94 adults and 23 youth volunteers involved in program
- **Family and Consumer Sciences**
 - Nutrition and Health
 - ✓ Monthly approximately 30 senior adults receive nutrition education classes with 21 reporting making changes in order to eat more healthy
 - ✓ 1960 youth received nutrition lessons with 42% of them reporting knowledge gain
 - Early Childhood Education
 - ✓ 27 early childhood professionals participate in training in order to keep mandatory certification
 - Parenting Education
 - ✓ Bi-monthly classes are provided for families court ordered to participate in parenting classes
